The Commission will consider proposed amendments to ADEM Administrative Code Division 335-6, Vol. 2, Water Quality Program Regulations (UST), Chapter 335-6-15, Technical Standards, Correction Action Requirements and Financial Responsibility for Owners and Operators of Underground Storage Tanks. Proposed revisions would provide an inflationary adjustment to the Underground Storage Tank Regulation Fee. The Department held a public hearing on the proposed amendments on February 9, 2023.

# 5. <u>CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ADEM ADMINISTRATIVE CODE DIVISION</u> <u>335-14, HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM REGULATIONS</u>

The Commission will consider proposed amendments to ADEM Administrative Code Division 335-14, Hazardous Waste Program Regulations to adopt two newly codified and revised federal rules promulgated by EPA. The proposed amendments include Modernizing Ignitable Liquids Determinations and Conforming Changes to Canada-Specific Hazardous Waste Import-Export Recovery and Disposal Operations Codes. Additional modifications are also made to make general clarifications and to maintain equivalency with federal regulations. The Department held a public hearing on the proposed amendments on January 24, 2023.

The Guidelines for Public Comment are used in the application of ADEM Administrative Code 335-2, Environmental Management Commission Regulations, Rule 335-2-3-.05, Agenda and Public Participation. The Guidelines for Public Comment serve to educate and inform the public as to how the Commission interprets and intends to apply the Rule. The revised Rule 335-2-3-.05 was effective October 7, 2016.
