# **Scrap Tire Decals**

# **ADEM Scrap Tire Transporter Decals**

In accordance with Alabama Scrap Tire Regulations (ADEM Admin. Code 335-4), any registered receiver or permitted transporter is required to exhibit a decal issued by ADEM when transporting shipments of greater than 8 scrap tires. The decal shall be placed on each vehicle in the fleet and be clearly visible at all times. The decal shall be placed on the left side of the vehicle, either on the windshield or the side of the vehicle immediately behind the driver's side door. The transporter or receiver shall maintain a list of decal assignments to specific vehicles, and may request new decals when additional vehicles are added, or when decals are lost, damaged or destroyed. Permitted scrap tire transporter decals are valid for three years; with the expiration year indicated by the first two digits of the decal number and change color each year (see examples below). Scrap tire receiver decals are white and they do not change color (see example below). These decals are only issued to registered receivers and they do not expire.

Numbered decals are provided by ADEM to receivers and transporters and are not assignable to other vehicles. The transporter or receiver may paint or scribe in some manner the decal information on the side of the vehicle immediately behind the driver's side door if the information placed on the vehicle clearly provides all information on the ADEM decal. Letters and numbers placed on the vehicle in this manner shall be at least one (1) inch in height. Letters and numbers shall be enduring and not change appearance with time.

Receivers are not required to use a permitted transporter for purposes of transporting their tires or their customers' tires between their business locations or between a customer site and the receiver. A receiver (white decals) may not transport another receiver's tires without first obtaining a scrap tire transporter permit.






