

Alabama Recycling Fund Grants Program Top 10



- 1. Proposals that request funding <u>only</u> or <u>mostly</u> for recycling program (infrastructure) costs, which may include equipment, facilities and other costs approved by the Department.
- 2. Proposals that are well planned, include all documentation required, and include a plan that is thorough and well adapted for their particular location.
- **3. Regionalization!** Proposals involving multiple governmental jurisdictions get preference.
- **4.** Proposals that request funding for promotion of **recycling**, **recycling** education, and **recycling** program advertising are allowed if they are only a small portion of the overall amount requested, are specific to the particular program, and will benefit that program.
- **5.** Proposals must utilize all existing public and private recycling infrastructure to the greatest extent possible.
- **6.** Projects **must** be compatible with the Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) under which the jurisdiction is covered.
- **7.** Proposals for development and implementation of recycling programs in jurisdictions <u>without</u> existing programs shall receive priority.
- **8.** Proposals which target multiple materials for recycling will receive priority over those that focus primarily on a few material types.
- **9.** Proposals which target multiple sources for recycling of materials will receive priority over those that focus on primarily one or few sources
- **10.** Proposals for projects/activities that will be supported by funding sources in addition to the Alabama Recycling Fund will receive priority.
